

ValuesPOLICY

Rationale:

To provide a happy, safe, supportive and stimulating environment where children can maximise their potential so that they can make a worthwhile contribution at school, home and the wider community.

- Freedom / Humour to embrace all we do and all we face
- Doing your best / Excellence in achieving our personal best in all that we do
- Fair go / Persistence to pursue and protect the common good and to overcome all that is before us
- Honesty and Trustworthiness in all our actions

Implementation:

As a school we attempt to apply these in our everyday dealings with each other and in the development of our programs and policies. The school believes it is important to provide a pleasant, safe and caring atmosphere where students can gain a sense of social responsibility and discipline with a positive attitude towards learning, teachers and parents/community. An emphasis should be placed on parent and community involvement with the school.

In our Dromana School community these core values are demonstrated when:

- Partnerships between students, staff, parents and the wider community are fostered and valued.
- Members of the school community show confidence in one another.
- Students are encouraged to negotiate, work cooperatively and collaboratively with their peers and other members of the school community and to be active and responsible citizens.
- Students, teachers and parents feel that they are being treated fairly at all times.
- Students have the opportunity to learn in a positive, safe and caring environment, taking responsibility for their learning and behaviour.
- All students will be encouraged to achieve their personal best.
- Students feel safe and secure and are prepared to accept challenges.
- Teaching and learning programs encourage deep understandings and a sense of importance of learning.
- Success and effort are acknowledged and celebrated.
